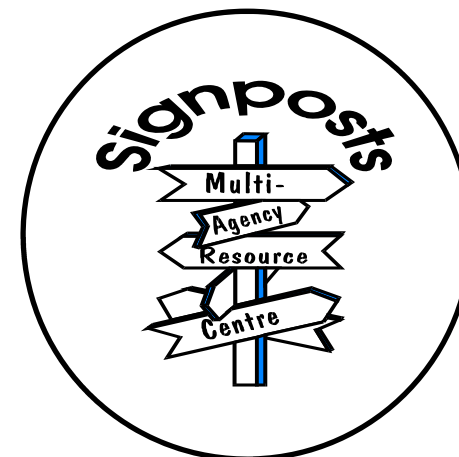

The Preston Pupil Mobility Project began in March 2003 and works with families moving into or around Preston helping them to find appropriate services and settle in their new communities.

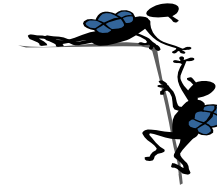
We welcome referrals to this project at any time.
